Shoppes at Hamilton Well Worth the Ride!!

Stanbery Development invested a great deal in Hamilton when it decided to construct a multi million dollar retail center which it was convinced was a winner. One of the most impressive shopping centers in the state is up and running on Route 130 North and has a collection of the most popular retail establishments in the Central Jersey area.

Included on the site are outstanding restaurants, the First Choice Bank, a variety establishments and dozens of the most popular clothing companies in the country. A current traffic situation provides no access for 130 South bound travel to make a left into the Shoppes at Hamilton center; a temporary inconvenience. Various alternative plans to alleviate this matter are being reviewed for implementation.

Currently, a vehicle heading south on Route 130 must pass the shopping center a short distance and exit the first right onto Route 156 proceeding to the first signal light at South Broad Street. Make a left at that intersection and a half minute up on the left is a north bound entrance back to Route 130. A mile up

on the right is the first entrance to the Shoppes at Hamilton; two entrances are available.

The closest retail center that comes close to the quality and variety of Shoppes at Hamilton is the Market Place at Princeton on Route 1. The trip down 130 as opposed to Route 1 is far more convenient and more accessible.



So, notwithstanding the situation, the Shoppes at Hamilton, is still the closest and most up to date quality packed operation in the area. Once you visit Shoppes at Hamilton, you will return again and again to enjoy the many varieties of class retail stores and the fresh, welcoming atmosphere that is located in your hometown!
